John Lennon was born in Liverpool, England in 1940.

He studied Arts and wanted to be an artist.

In 1962 he formed a band called The Beatles with Paul McCartney, George Harrison and Ringo Star. In 1968 John married a Japanese girl named Yoko Ono.

The band broke up in 1970 shortly after recording one of the greatest albums, Let It Be. In 1975 John's and Yoko's son, Sean, was born. John wrote "Imagine" in 1971, the lyrics tried to support the anti-war movement as many people were protesting against the Vietnam War at that time. "Imagine" reminds us to think about alternatives to conflict and violence and it is one of the greatest songs of all times.

On December 8, 1980, a young man shot John outside his home in New York. John died in a police car on the way to the hospital.
